Feet First, the National Parks Service, and community members are mapping important walking trails and community assets in North East Seattle. The trails – made of safe and pleasant streets, staircases, and nature trails – will connect communities through walking. We look forward to your participation as we create the first Northeast Seattle Trails network and map.

GOALS OF THE NEST PROJECT:

- Increase walking and other alternative forms of transportation
- Increase knowledge of local resources, natural resources
- Increase network of people who can mobilize to improve pedestrian infrastructure (trails, sidewalks)

NORTH EAST SEATTLE TRAILS EXPECTED OUTCOMES:

- A planned trail network (includes streets, sidewalks, trails, anywhere you walk) based on extensive community input and plans already created by the different neighborhoods
- A neighborhoods on foot map of the trail network
- Proposed locations for future way-finding kiosks (that have maps and neighborhood information)
- Website about the project
